Sarah's big moment

EXCITED Melton dancer Sarah Jaggard will be performing at this year's Glastonbury – the world's biggest music festival.

The star-studded line-up for this year's festival, from June 27 to 29, includes The Verve, Jay Z and the Kings Of Leon and 175,000 people are expected.

Sarah (27), a freelance dancer, choreographer and teacher, dances for the agency Area 51 which is contracted to perform entertainment between acts.

Sarah, of Burton Lazars, said: "I've never been to Glastonbury before so it's going to be amazing.

"I'm going to be there for all three days. I'll probably be doing some stilt walking during the daytime and performing in shows in the evenings."

Sarah started dancing when she was three in Rearsby. She went on to join Trevonne Stage School in Melton and later Brooksby Melton College.

This was followed by a dance degree in Leeds and a year's training at a contemporary dance company in London. She now teaches at Stagecoach and at King Edward VII School.
